Spellings - A list of 10 spellings will be sent home. Please practise these with your child and encourage them to write sentences using these words. Spelling tests will take place every Friday.

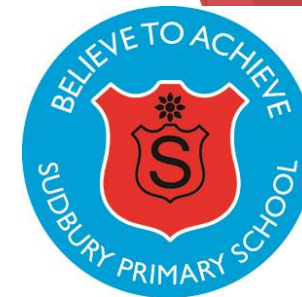
